- **3. Read Ephesians 2:10.** Do you think this verse applies to every believer? How does it affect the way you live every day?
- **4.** Read Matthew 25:23, 26. (Read the whole story in Matthew 25:23-30). What does the master in the story have invested in his servants? How much did he trust them? What did he expect of them? Does the master's judgment seem fair to you? Which servant do you most relate to? Why?

**5.** What would help you to better use what "talents" God has given you: To recognize them? To be more responsible? To believe in yourself as someone God trusts with His gifts? To get more encouragement from others? To trust in God more?
