### Talk About It

**1.** Were you ever disappointed by not receiving a gift that you expected? What was it? How did you react?

Read About It: Luke 2:10-11; Genesis 6:5-7; Galatians 4:4; Matthew 2:1-2; Psalms 24:5.

# Think About It

- 2. Read Luke 2:10-11. What is so strange about the shepherds being chosen as to receive the announcement of Christ's birth? What is so appropriate about it?
- 3. Read Genesis 6:5-7. How do you feel when your read about God's sadness at human wickedness? Why was the flood his solution to the problem? What about Noah? What do you think God's response to wickedness today is?
- **4. Read Galatians 4:4.** Why do you imagine the time of Jesus' birth was the "right time"?
- **5. Read Matthew 2:1-2.** What does the appearance of the wise men tell us about God's purposes? What is ironic about their appearance in the story?

6. Read Psalms 24:5. What can you do differently to better celebrate Christ's birth this year? How can you prepare yourself for what God is wants to do next in your life?
